Amanda would give a concerted effort to be into anything and everything, Amanda had a curiosity and a lust for life that had enough fuel to power our family and relationship for eternity, with Amanda I never had to ask for anything, she would always make coffee every morning, always a massive cup that took an hour to cool down and that I couldn't ever finish but it didn't matter, I saw the effort, I saw the consistency. I'm the type that tries his absolute hardest not to be a burden to anyone, so when I had soccer matches far away I wouldn't really mention just because I knew it would be a big request to have her there, but it didn't matter, she would pry and interrogate me for the details and she would be there, at every game, sometimes without telling me she was coming.
